

Presenting AComIn at the “ICT innovations in SMEs” Plovdiv International Fair 2014

On September 30th 2014, BAIT (Bulgarian Association of Information Technologies) organised a workshop “ICT innovations in Small and Medium-sized Enterprises” within the International Autumn Technical Fair in Plovdiv.



Organising the event is part of the activities carried out by the National Office for Technology Transfer (OTT) in the field of Information Technologies, created by BAIT in relation to project BG161PO003-1.2.02-0051-C0001 within Operational Programme “Competitiveness”.

The aim of the workshop is to present the ICT capabilities and good practices, supporting the development of digital entrepreneurship and IT skills in Bulgaria.

Prof. Galia Angelova, project coordinator, presented AComIn and the activities for advanced IT application development, carried out within the project.



The workshop was opened by Mrs. Sonya Petkova, Head of the TTO in Information Technologies in BAIT. Mrs. Vesela Kalacheva – CEO of BAIT, presented the tasks of the National Office for Technology Transfer: to enable the technology transfer process between the scientific and RTD entities and users of innovations in practice by facilitating the communication between entrepreneurs, ICT companies in Bulgaria and scientists providing innovations on the part of universities, research organisations and others.



Prof. Galia Angelova presented the AComIn project and its mission and emphasized specifically on the development of scientific prototypes for innovative applications. The SmartLab devices purchased within the project, as well as the activities of solving practical problems using the new equipment, were introduced. Imprint models of objects, created using the 3D printer aroused the public interest and provoked lively discussions.

The event was attended by IT experts, mainly from software companies, participants and guests in the fair.
